Ministry of Women and Child Development has developed a Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for rehabilitation of children in conflict with law. The underlying premise for treating children differently when they come into the Juvenile Justice System is their receptivity to positive influence and is more likely to change their behavior as compared to adults. This reflects an understanding the children have great potential to be rehabilitated and reintegrated back into their communities and that this can be the key to preventing children from escalating into prolific adult offending.
