Subject: Review meeting on the progress of Direct Benefit Transfer under Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY) and Dhanalakshmi Scheme.

Madam/Sir

This relates to the implementation of Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY) and Dhanalakshmi Scheme which are under Direct Benefit Transfer.

2. At present nine districts in nine States are covered for the Phase-I of implementation of DBT for IGMSY. They are Amaravati (Maharashtra), North Goa (Goa), Dharwad (Karnataka), Chandigarh (Chandigarh), North-West Delhi (Delhi), Diu (Daman & Diu), Udaipur (Rajasthan), West Sikkim (Sikkim), Dhalai (Tripura). For Phase -I, Dhanalakshmi Scheme under DBT is operational in one district of Punjab i.e Fatehgarh Sahib.

3. For the Phase-II of DBT, which will start from 01-07-2013 as prescribed by PMO, seven districts for IGMSY have been identified. They are Palakad (Kerala), Yanam (Puducherry), West Delhi (Delhi), Nalgonda (Andhra Pradesh), Hamirpur (Himachal Pradesh), Lakshadweep (Lakshadweep), Dhamtari (Chhattisgarh). For Phase -II, Dhanalakshmi Scheme under DBT will be operational in one district of Uttar Pradesh i.e Rae Bareilly.

4. A meeting to discuss the progress of the Phase -I and modalities of implementing the Direct Benefit Transfer scheme in Phase -II is being organized under the chairmanship of Special Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development on Friday, the 10th May, 2013 at 10.30 A.M. at National Institute of Public Cooperation and Child Development, 5 Siri Institutional Area, Hauz Khas, New Delhi.

5. It is, therefore, requested to kindly attend the meeting along-with the concerned Programme Director, District Programme Officer, Nodal Officer for these States/Districts for the said meeting. It is also requested that progress made so far by your State/UT in DBT may be sent for the meeting in the attached template by 6th May 2013. It may be mentioned that TA/DA will be borne by the respective State Government.
