Subject:- Implementation of Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY).

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is regarding implementation of the IGMSY in your State/UT. As you are aware, IGMSY is a 100% centrally sponsored, Conditional Cash Transfer Scheme introduced in 2010-11 on pilot basis in 53 districts across the country. The scheme is being implemented using the platform of ICDS. As per the scheme guidelines, the State/UT Governments are responsible for implementing the scheme and monitoring day-to-day activities. As a part of the preparatory activities, the State Governments/UT Administrations had to print IGMSY registers for keeping proper record/data of the scheme. The cost of printing of IGMSY registers may be borne by the implementing States/UTs from the contingency fund allocation under the scheme.

2. Recently, Secretary, WCD, Maharashtra has sought clarification from this Ministry for provision of booking of the expenditure for printing of registers etc. In this connection, it is clarified that **the contingency fund may be used for printing of registers, scheme guidelines, monitoring formats, translation in local language, reports, postage, stationery, telephone with STD, Xerox, hiring of data entry operator for digitisation of beneficiary data etc.**

3. The grants-in-aid released under the scheme to State Government/UT Administrations includes Cost Component for beneficiaries @ Rs. 6000 per beneficiary (increased from Rs. 4000 to Rs. 6000 w.e.f from 5th July 2013), Cost of State Cells (including non-recurring and recurring expenditure), Cost of District Cells (including non-recurring and recurring expenditure), incentives for AWW/AWH @ Rs. 300 per beneficiary, Flexi-funds @ 2.5%, Training and IEC @ 3% and Contingency @2% of the total amount.

4. The State Government/UT Administrations are requested to incur expenditure as per the budget provision mentioned in para' 3' above for implementation of the scheme.
