Madam/Sir,

This is in connection to rollout of Direct Benefit Transfer in Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY) scheme.As you may be aware at present nine districts in nine States are covered for the implementation of IGMSY scheme under Phase-I of DBT. These districts are Amaravati (Maharashtra), Chandigarh (Chandigarh), North Goa (Goa), Dharwad (Karnataka), North-West Delhi (Delhi), Diu (Daman and Diu), Udaipur (Rajasthan), West Sikkim (Sikkim) and Dhalai (Tripura). Seven additional districts in six States have been identified for implementation in Phase-II of DBT roll out. The districts in Phase –II are Palakkad (Kerala), Yanam (Pondicherry), West Delhi (Delhi), Hamirpur (Himachal Pradesh),Lakshadweep (Lakshadweep), Dhamtari (Chhattisgarh), Nalgonda (Andhra Pradesh).DBT system envisages direct payment to beneficiaries based on Aadhaar number through Aadhaar Payment Bridge (APB)system.

2. Further, it is informed to you that a decision has been taken in the review meeting held in Prime Minister Office on 30.08.2013 by Principle Secretary to PM. **It states that “As regards, Indira Gandhi Matritva Shayog Yojana (IGMSY), which is currently under implementation in 53 districts, it was decided to continue with the current mode of implementation, without making DBT mandatory.However, in respect of beneficiaries who had both an Aadhaar number and a bank account, implementation will be through the DBT mode”.**

3. It may also be noted that the payment of the beneficiaries registered under IGMSY should not be withheld or delayed due to non-availability of the Aadhaar number. At the same time, it is reiterated that the beneficiaries should be encouraged to register for Aadhaar number after registration in the scheme.

4. These instructions are issued with the approval of the Secretary (WCD).
