

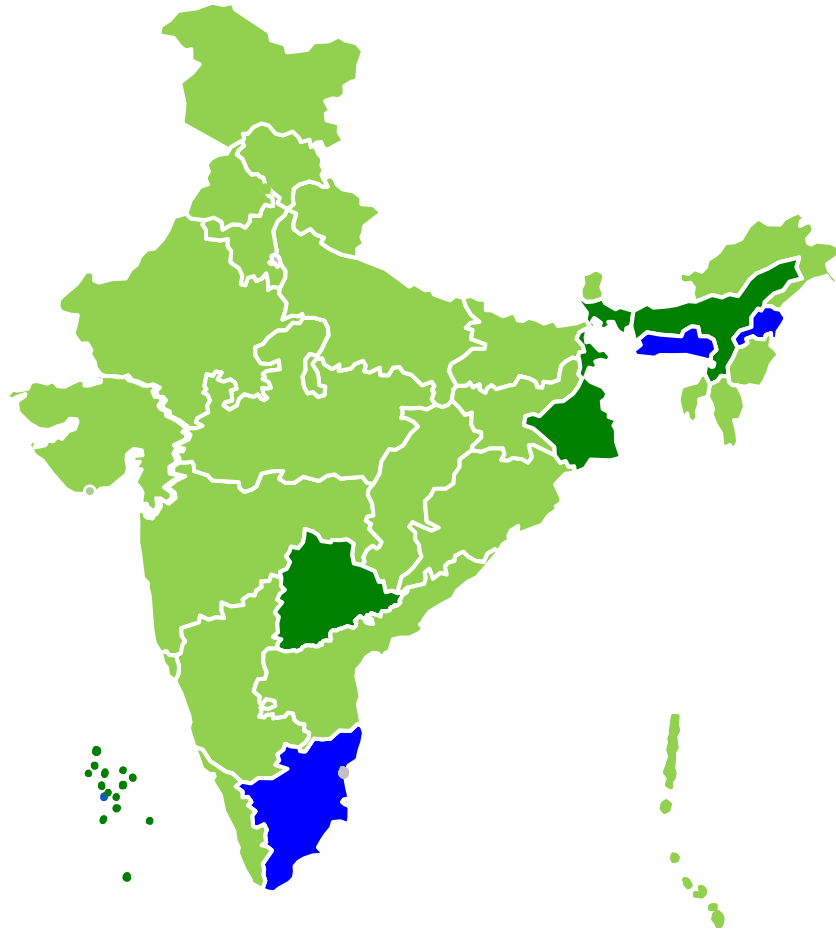

Important State specific Issues

Clear backlog by May 31 in Mission mode

- Collect all backlog applications within a week & ensure entry of all these applications by 10th April
 - All bunched applications to be processed together by staff
- Close monitoring needs to be done through VCs and WhatsApp [Daily]

LGD Saturation: Master Mapping to be completed

- Villages/Towns that are still not uploaded in PMMVY-CAS needs to be done by 31st March.
- All AWCs/ASHAs/ANMs should be mapped in PMMVY-CAS
- Urban Areas to be uploaded as well on priority
- Detailed state wise analysis is provided in the embed document.
- Assigning additional charge in case of vacancies in field

Important State specific Issues

Expediting fund disbursal & Bunching of Instalments

- Funds should not be kept parked in Escrow/Treasury and approvals should be given quickly
- All India [47% of applications paid](#) are of 1st instalment only.
 - So, the 2nd and 3rd instalment forms of these beneficiaries must be target
 - Detailed State/UT wise analysis is in the embed file:

Clearing Pendency & Correction by 31st March

- All Sanctioning authorities (including SNO) to clear applications thrice a day and not leave office until cleared
- Correction queue to be cleared by 31st March in mission mode

Fund Contribution by States/UTs

- Ensure timely transfer of State/UT share of funds
- Ensure weekly and monthly reporting of Expenditure

Important State specific Issues

Draft Rules under NSFA

- Finalise and share by 31st March 2018 positively

Create Awareness and ensure supervision

- Anganwadi Workers/ASHAs - Identify all potential beneficiaries
- Daily monitoring of progress at district level for all blocks

Set up State level Coordination Committee

- How to utilise the flexi-funds for expediting the implementation
- Regular training to be ensured for all field staff & highlight the common sources of errors

Important State specific Issues

IEC Activities in local language

- State to take-up intensive IEC Campaign

Incentivize scheme staff

- Measures to be taken to incentive the scheme staff for improving performance
- QR code readers may be used to minimize data entry errors

Notify change in SNO

- Notify the change well in advance
- Ensure that this doesn't affect the availability of DSC for approving payments.
