UNICEF Support: Behavior Change Education / Jan Andolan

- Jan Andolan
 - Conceptualizing & planning
 - Designing communication content and materials
 - Measurement to assess impact
- Social and behavior change strategies
 - Building capacities of frontline functionaries on communication and counselling
 - Mass media
 - Demonstrating effective approaches for social and behavior change
- Linking with existing BCC programs and schemes C²IQ:
 - MAA, PMSMA, Anaemia mukt Bharat, Swachh Bharat Mission, Self Help Groups, etc...
- Non- government actors
 - Nutrition ambassadors (Bollywood, sports); local & community leaders; mother support groups; private sector; academia; etc

UNICEF Support: Evidence generation

- Monitoring systems surveys, nutrition information systems, dash boards, state and district score cards
 - Comprehensive National Nutrition Survey: 0-18 years old; all States; anthropometry, health, WASH, physical and mental development; blood, urine, stool samples – e.g. parasites, micronutrients.
 - Results April: December 2018.
- Evidence generation secondary analysis on drivers for undernutrition; operational research – what works and should be scaled up
