Guidelines for Incentive Awards as part of POSHAN Abhiyaan

1. Objective

- 1.1 The guidelines are being framed in pursuance of the administrative approval of the NNM/7/2017-WBP dated 26 February 2018 .
- 1.2 The Objective of these Guidelines is to define the framework for the Award of Incentives at the State/UT Level and to reward the field functionaries engaged in the implementation of the POSHAN Abhiyaan.
- 1.3 There will be no separate Anganwadi Awards from 2018-2019 onwards.

2. Grouping of States/UTs

- 2.1 The 36 States/UTs have been grouped into 4 Groups based on the population; number of Anganwadis; geographical location and administrative setup.
- 2.2 The grouping of States/UTs is given at **Annexure I**.

3. Category of Awards

3.1 National Awards

The following Awards will be given at National Level. Annexure II

3.2 MoW&CD may at its discretion finalize non-incentive Awards, to recognize the efforts of participating Line Ministries, Multilaterals and Partners supporting POSHAN Abhiyaan. All such awards will be brought before the Selection Committee.

4. **Periodicity of Awards**

4.1 The National and State Level Awards will be given based on performance each. For beginning FY 2018-19 for implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan. **The Award criteria will** primarily take into consideration the **rollout and implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan.** The **performance of all districts** notified as part of POSHAN Abhiyaan will be considered towards the Awards.

5. **Evaluation Criteria and Citation Format for the Awards**

(National Awards)

5.1 **Common Application Software (CAS) Implementation Award:** This award will take into consideration the progress made in procurement of smartphones, SIM cards & Data Plans, and Growth Monitoring Devices; configuration of smartphones for rollout of CAS; training of master trainers and field functionaries on the software; this will be followed by the roll-out of (CAS) in the State/UT. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at **Annexure III.**

5.2 <u>Capacity Building, Convergence and Behavioural Change & Community</u> <u>Mobilisation Award</u>:

5.2.1 Capacity Building (ILA)

Training of field functionaries and supervisory staff through the Incremental Learning Approach (ILA) is an essential component of the Mission, ensuring their empowerment and professional competence. This will take into consideration the establishment of SRG, DRG & BRG. This will be followed by the number of modules covered as part of the training at these three levels, including the number of individuals trained. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at *Annexure IV*.

5.2.2 Convergence

Along with this POSHAN Abhiyaan focuses on achieving convergence at all levels. Accordingly, States/UTs were required to formulate respective Convergence Action Plans. This Award will look at implementation of Convergence Action Plan and holding of quarterly meetings at State, district and block levels. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at **Annexure V**.

5.2.3 <u>Behavioural Change & Community Mobilisation Award</u>: The goals of the Mission can only be achieved through the involvement of beneficiaries, their families and the society. This Award will focus on the allotment of funds to districts for conduct of Community Based events (CBE) and the number of CBE & VHSND conducted at district level. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at *Annexure VI*.

5.3 **Overall Excellence in Implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan:** This award, in addition to accounting for the above four Component based Awards, will also focus on setting up of SPMU; hiring of manpower at District & Block level; utilization of funds allotted and State level budget contribution, wherever applicable. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at **Annexure VII.**

The States/UT will carryout selection based on the defined criteria and forward the final awardee along with the qualifying citations of each set of awards. (State/UT will send only 1 final awardee citation each under all 3 category.)

5.4 **Field Level Leadership Awards:** These would be team Awards given at the district, block and field levels, to recognize outstanding work done by the cutting-edge leadership as well as field functionaries in implementing the Mission components and achieving Convergence.

5.4.1 <u>District Level Leadership & Convergence Award</u>: This would be a team award at district level and the team of DC/DM, DPO/DSWO, Chief District Medical Officer (CDMO/CMO), Head of Rural Development of District etc. will be nominated for these awards. The qualifying act of the citation will include roll-out of POSHAN Abhiyaan Components, leadership initiatives towards achieving convergence, innovation, interventions, awareness campaigns, use of technology etc. *(State will send only 1 final awardee citation) Annexure VIII.*

5.4.2 Block Level Leadership & Convergence Award: This would be a team award at block level and the team of CDPO, MO I/C, Incharge of Rural Development of Block etc.

will be nominated for these awards. The qualifying act of the citation will include rollout of POSHAN Abhiyaan Components, leadership initiatives towards achieving convergence, innovation, interventions, awareness campaigns, use of technology etc. (State/UT will send only 1 final awardee citation) Annexure IX.

The States/UT will carryout selection based on the defined criteria and forward the list of final awardees along with the qualifying citations of each set of awards .

5.4.3 <u>AAAA&LS (AWW, AWH, ASHA, ANM) Convergence Award</u>: As part of convergence it is essential that the field functionaries at ground level AAAA&LS (AWW, AWH, ASHA, ANM&LS) synergise their efforts during various activities like counselling during home visits (including visits carried out as part of HBNC & HBYC), CBE and VHSND. To acknowledge this aspect and send a message on the importance of this field level synergy, a total of 65 set of AAAA&LS will be awarded from across the Country at the National Level in Delhi. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at *Annexure X*. Based on the criteria the States/UTs will carry out evaluation within the State and names of the final set as per no. of district given in (Annexure IIA) of AAAA&LS nominations for award will be forwarded. Each State will forward the 2 citation and UTs will forward 1 citation.

6 . Evaluation Criteria and Citation Format for the Awards

State Level Awards:

6.1 **District Level Leadership & Convergence Award**: This would be a team award at district level and the team of DC/DM, DPO/DSWO, Chief District Medical Officer (CDMO/CMO), Head of Rural Development of District etc. will be nominated for these awards. The qualifying act of the citation will include roll-out of POSHAN Abhiyaan Components, leadership initiatives towards achieving convergence, innovation, interventions, awareness campaigns, use of technology etc.

6.2 **Block Level Leadership & Convergence Award:** This would be a team award at block level and the team of CDPO, MO I/C, Incharge of Rural Development of Block etc. will be nominated for these awards. The qualifying act of the citation will include roll-out of POSHAN Abhiyaan Components, leadership initiatives towards achieving convergence, innovation, interventions, awareness campaigns, use of technology etc.

6.3 <u>Best Field Team Award at Block Level (comprising AAAA and Lady</u> <u>Supervisor</u>): As part of convergence it is essential that the field functionaries at ground level AAAA&LS (AWW, AWH, ASHA, ANM&LS) synergise their efforts during various activities like counselling during home visits (including visits carried out as part of HBNC & HBYC), CBE, VHSND and message delivery. To acknowledge this aspect in each block and send a message on the importance of this field level synergy, a set of AAAA&LS will be awarded in all the Blocks across all districts based on performance.

The set of AAAA&LS will have to obtain a minimum score of 50 to be eligible for the Award. Incase NOT even a single set of AAAA&LS is able to obtain the required qualification score in a Block, NO Awards will be given in that Block. Details of evaluation criteria and citation format are given at *Annexure XIII*. Based on the criteria the States/UTs will carry out evaluation within each Block and names of the best set of AAAA&LS will be intimated to MoW&CD in the given timeframe. These Incentive Awards will be managed and distributed at the State Level in manner similar to what is being followed at the National level. Only the list of awardees along with the score cards will be forwarded by States/UTs to MoW&CD, no citations will be forwarded. The required funds based on the number of awards shall be transferred to the States/UTs.

.7. Award Committees

7.1 <u>Constitution of Shortlisting Committee at State/UT Level</u>: State/UT may constitute a Selection Committee or use the Convergence Committee constituted under POSHAN Abhiyaan at their discretion to shortlist/select the awardees . **Based on the committes recommendation, the State Department of WCD/SW will forward the list of Awardees for National Awards to the nodel person in Department of WCD,GOI. The committee will also recommend the State level Awardees to the respective State Government Departments.**

7.2 **Constitution of Selection and Confirming Committee at National Level:** The following Committees will be formed to finalise the Awards at the National Level.

7.2.1 A Screening Committee under Mission Director will be formed at the national level. This committee will ensure that all the nomination received from States/UTs are as per format and meet all the qualification criteria. *Annexure XII.*

7.2.2 Selection Committee under Secretary, WCD will be formed to finalize the Awards. *Annexure XIII.*

8. Administrative/General Instructions

8.1 <u>Mode of Submission</u>: Citations in the given format, will be forwarded through email and hard copy of the citations duly sealed will also be forwarded, to the following address.

8.2 The Citations will be forwarded **through proper channel**. Department of **W&CD/Social Welfare will be the nodal Department** for forwarding all the citations at State as well district level. Department of W&CD/Social Welfare will also consult the department of Health for deciding the AAAA & LS award. All Citations either through email or by post should be sent under a forwarding letter from Department of W&CD/Social Welfare. Citations forwarded directly through email without a covering letter will NOT be considered for the Awards.

8.3 <u>Format for Submission</u>: Category wise format for Citation is given at paragraph above. The format of the citation has been prepared in a manner that it will help the States/UTs, as well as, CPMU to monitor and evaluate the progress of the Mission. It is mandatory for all States/UTs to report as per the formats by the due date. Wherever possible citations to be supported by photographic evidence with date time stamp. Soft copy of the citations being forwarded through email will be in word and pdf formats only. All photographs to be attached with the citation will be duly annotated and compiled in a pdf format.

8.4 The last date for receipt of citation will be communicated sepretely.

9. **Use of Award Money:** The States/UTs may use the award money (given for the purpose of State level Award) towards any gap filling or innovations.
