Subject: State Resource Group, District Resource Group, Block Resource Group and Sector level Incremental Learning training under POSHAN *Abhiyaan* -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

Please refer to this Ministry's letter of even No dated 25th January 2018, forwarding therewith guidelines for Incremental Learning Approach (ILA) under POSHAN *Abhiyaan* and also refer to Administrative Guidelines dated 26th February, 2018.

2. As per ILA guidelines, there is provision of conducting State Resource Group (SRG) and District Resource Group (DRG) training for 3 modules on quarterly basis and Block Resource Group (BRG) and Sector Level training on monthly basis.

3. On examination of the issues, it has been noticed that various States have not yet started Incremental Learning module training due to some or other reason. As per Administrative approval 21 modules should be finished by March 2020. All modules are equally important and have been planned in a way so as to give crisp knowledge to the service providers and to beneficiaries. Now there are just 17 months left and would be difficult to complete 21 modules for States/UTs by March 2020.

4. After discussion between Ministry and World Bank there was a suggestion to change the norms for all States/UTs to do SRG and DRG training for 3 modules at an interval of 45 days and BRG and Sector Level training twice in a month to cope up the time loss.

5. In view of above, with approval of competent authority, it has been decided to revise the norms of Incremental Learning training. Accordingly, States/UTs are requested to conduct SRG and DRG training for 3 modules at an interval of 45 days and BRG and Sector Level training twice in a month.
