## Contours of the proposed 'Swastha Balak Spardha"

Swastha Balak Spardha is proposed to be conducted with the following objectives:

- To bring focus on the "Swastha Balak- Healthy Child"
- To identify healthy children in age group of 6m-3 years and 3-5 years
- To generate awareness and conduct campaigns for growth measurement of children under 5 years
- To generate a spirit of competitiveness for good health and nutrition
- To promote Breastfeeding and Complementary feeding practices
- To promote counselling regarding importance of diet diversity and age appropriate feeding
- To promote concept of peer educator (mother-to-mother/ family/ community)

#### **Target Group**

Primary Beneficiary: Children (6m-3 years and 3-5 years)

Secondary: Care-givers (Parents, Other Family Members, Other local persons)

#### Recognition

- 1. Ranking of children 1st, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 2. Distribution of Certificate to Winning Child and Parent (especially mothers, to encourage spirit of positive competition) and reward like indigenous toys, hygiene kit, water bottle, fruit basket etc.
- 3. Small gifts like nutrition kit/ hygiene kit to all participating children
- 4. Locally available indigenous toys may be used to felicitate the children.

#### **Outline of the Program**

The actual Spardha will be a **one -day event**, in the nature of a celebratory tyohar / festival, wherein the children will be ranked and certificates / prizes distributed.

<u>Indicative preparatory Events leading up to the actual day of the Spardha:</u>

- I. Preparing line list of the children at AWCs
- II. Activities for awareness and dissemination of information to the beneficiaries, parents / family members etc about the Spardha to ensure wide-spread participation
- III. Involvement of PRI members to ensure their presence and to mobilize and sensitise general public about importance of the health of children
- IV. Coordination with the Health department (Health check up of children)
- V. Cleanliness of the AWCs and availability of drinking water, hand hygiene and sanitation facilities (water, towel, soap)
- VI. Ensuring growth monitoring equipment, Growth charts and Community growth charts for counseling
- VII. Training of AWWs/AWHs for proper growth measurement and maintaining proper record of the Criteria for marking, including status of hygiene of the child, vaccination and de-worming records, records of HCM / THR consumption etc.
- VIII. Identifying the institutions /associations / organizations such as SHGs and Village Development Committee, Youth Clubs, Educational Institutions / Schools, ASHA, ANM, IMA, Paediatric Associations, Mahila Arogya Samitis, Sanitation Committees, organizations like Lions Club, Rotary Club etc that can facilitate awareness, mobilisation and sensitization of general public
  - IX. Outreach/Media Plan: Ensure full and active participation by all stakeholders
  - X. Devising a Plan for involvement of Local leaders / VIPs / Influencers/ sports personalities / Film Personalities to popularise the event and ensure participation of children and parents in huge numbers in the event.

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
