A Webroom / Video Conference meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MWCD with the States/UTs on 31st August, 2020 at 12.00 noon to apprise them about the themes to be focused during the Rashtriya Poshan Maah 2020, to be held in September, 2020 with representatives of State Departments of Women & Child Development/Social Welfare, Health & Family Welfare and Panchayati Raj along with Union Ministries of Health & Family Welfare and Panchayati Raj.

Minutes of meeting regarding Poshan Maah with the States/UTs and Ministries of Health & Family Welfare/ Panchayati Raj held on 31st August, 2020

A meeting was convened under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MWCD with the States/UTs on 31st August, 2020 at 12.00 noon to apprise them about the themes to be focused during the Rashtriya Poshan Maah 2020, scheduled to be held in September, 2020. Representatives of State Departments of Women & Child Development/Social Welfare, Health & Family Welfare and Panchayati Raj along with Union Ministries of Health & Family Welfare and Panchayati Raj participated in the meeting. The main themes highlighted in the meeting were: (i) Promotion of Nutri-Gardens (ii) Breast feeding and (iii) Management of Severely Acute Malnutrition (SAM) Children.

- 2. At the outset, Joint Secretary & Mission Director POSHAN Abhiyaan welcomed all the participants. While urging the States to join wholeheartedly in celebrating Poshan Maah, she also drew attention towards the necessity for adherence to the COVID-19 protocols issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of Home Affairs. She invited the Secretary, MWCD to address the State nodal officers regarding the objective of Poshan Maah 2020 and the relevance of a Jan Andolan to address malnutrition.
- 3. Secretary, MWCD underscored the importance of the activities proposed to be conducted during Poshan Maah in laying a strong foundation for achieving the objectives of POSHAN Abhiyaan. He highlighted that Hon'ble Prime Minister, in his Mann ki Baat address, had explained the role played by nutrition & proper nourishment in helping children and students to attain their optimum potential. He further noted the efforts made during the past few years especially in villages where public participation in nutrition week & nutrition month (Poshan Maah) is converting nutrition awareness into a mass movement. Further, Secretary WCD emphasised that during Poshan Maah 2020 all the stakeholders should pursue Promotion of Nutri-Gardens in the Anganwadi Centre (AWC) premises/ on Community land, in convergence with the Ministry/ Department of Panchayati Raj, Rural Development and School Education & Literacy, to create a micro-nutrient environment in every village for local sourcing of fresh and nutrition rich vegetables, fruits, important herbs etc. He stressed upon the need for promoting Breast Feeding in continuation of breastfeeding week celebrated earlier this month. He advised that activities underscoring the importance of breastfeeding in the development of children must be undertaken. He further stated that Identification and management of SAM children shall be the focus activity to be kick started during Poshan Maah 2020 and will be continued then after. All the stakeholders were requested to make all out efforts in this regard.
- 4. Subsequently, Director, MWCD, made a presentation elaborating on the following points –

- Step by step process to be followed for operationalizing the objectives envisaged for Poshan Maah 2020 while adhering to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare protocols prescribed in the wake of COVID-19.
- · Activities to be undertaken during Poshan Maah.
- Reporting format for SAM with a request to States/UTs to translate the same in their local language.
- Awards & Incentives for Districts/ Teams for success in carrying our SAM drive.
- Data Entry for Jan Andolan Dashboard.
- Guidelines to be issued for identification, referral & management of SAM children.

A copy of the presentation is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

- 5. Representative of Ministry of Panchayati Raj indicated full support of MoPR and informed that an advisory will be issued to all the States/UTs. Dr. Manohar Agnani, JS, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare conveyed full support of MoH&FW for the activities to be undertaken during the Poshan Maah.
- 6. Joint Secretary, MWCD concluded the meeting while reiterating the following points
 - Childline Services (1098) will be participating in the Poshan Maah for community connect.
 - Digital mode for meetings and counseling may be encouraged to ensure adherence to COVID-19 protocols prescribed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of Home Affairs.
 - All stakeholders should upload the daily activities report on Jan Andolan Dashboard of POSHAN Abhiyaan.
 - All States/UTs were requested to nominate a nodal person and share his/her WhatsApp number so that information could get disseminated in a speedy manner.
 - Hashtag #PoshanMaah2020 to be duly publicised through Social / Print / News media. Weekly Hashtag will also be shared subsequently.
 - State/UT may organize State level webinar, talk shows on radio and TV, recipe demonstration, showcase of best practices etc during the month.
 - Community Radio may also be used extensively.
 - Digital Poshan Panchayat may be organized on weekly basis.
 - Departments of State/UT may work in tandem with respective line Ministries in the Center, for effective convergence and ensure implementation of the activities to be carried out during the month.
- 6. The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.

A Step Towards 'Kuposhan Mukt Bharat'

What is Severe Acute Malnutrition

- Severe Wasting as a recent occurrence
- Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) is defined by:
 - Very low weight-for-height / length (Z-score below 3 SD)
 - By visible severe wasting
 - By the presence of nutritional oedema
- According to NFHS-4 (2015-2016) about 7.5% of the Children under 5 years are severely wasted (weight-for-height)

CAUSES INCLUDE

- Inadequate food intake
- Incorrect feeding practices
- Disease
- Infection
- More frequently, a combination of these factors



Why Identification of SAM is Important

- Due to Covid-19, closure of AWCs and impact on growth monitoring
- Malnutrition is the dominant factor for 67.5% deaths of under-5 children
- Median case fatality rate in children suffering SAM is approximately 23.5%, which may reach 50% in oedematous malnutrition
- Children with Severe Acute Malnutrition are at higher risk of mortality if they develop illnesses like Diarrhoea, Pneumonia, Malaria etc.
- Identification of probable children suffering from SAM
 - House-to-House visit by AWW
 - Information to mothers by awareness
 - Other platforms like VHSND, Hospitals, and Poshan application









Data Entry on Jan Andolan Dashboard

Data Entry on Jan Andolan Dashboard:

- Data entry permitted at National, State, District and Block, Anganwadi Centre / Village level.
- Ministry / Department at various geographic levels to assign one focal person for data entry.
- The user credentials (user name and password) shall be only shared with the focal person.
- The data entry restricted from 12:00 a.m. 05:00 a.m.
- When system detects duplicate data entry, user will be notified and duplicate entry will be disallowed.
- Back-dated data entry restricted to previous 5 days. Data entry will close on 02nd October, 2020, 11:59 p.m.
- In case photo needs to be uploaded along with data, photo size to be below 2 MB.
