A meeting of the Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) for 'UJJAWALA' – A Comprehensive Scheme for Prevention of Trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation and Reintegration of Victims of Trafficking for Commercial Sexual Exploitation was held on **25.06.15 at 3.00 p.m.** under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Women and Child Development), in Room No.601, 'A' Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The proceedings were held through **Video-Conferencing** with all the concerned States. The PSC considered the review proposals received from the Non-Governmental Organizations duly recommended by the State Governments.

2. 32 review proposals for their further continuation from 9 States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telengana and Uttarakhand were considered by the Project Sanctioning Committee. Out of these, the Committee approved 21 proposals, 10 proposals were not approved and 1 proposal was deferred as per details given below.
