Subject: Allocation of Food Grains to States/UTs under Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP) and National Food Security Act (NFSA), 2013 to meet the Supplementary Nutrition under the Anganwadi Services [Umbrella Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme] for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters of the year 2021-22.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to convey the approval of the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India for total allocation of **2,43,759 (Two Lakh Forty Three Thousand & Seven Hundred & Fifty Nine) MTs of Wheat**, **1,55,313 (One Lakh Fifty Five Thousand Three Hundred & Thirteen) MTs of Rice** and **1,06,319 (One Lakh Six Thousand Three Hundred & Nineteen) MTs of Fortified Rice** to the State Governments/UT Administrations as per the quantities mentioned against each, under the **Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP)** and **National Food Security Act (NFSA)** at the subsidized price not exceeding **Rs. 3/- per kg for Rice** and **Rs. 2/- per kg for Wheat**, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of the year 2021-22:

- The allocated food grains should be lifted as per the guidelines laid down vide the Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2007-BP.II, dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2011 and will be used for the beneficiaries of the ICDS Scheme only. **The State Govts/UT Administrations are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting & utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.**
- The State Govts/UT Administrations are further requested to furnish the Utilization Certificates (UCs) along with off take figures for the quantity of food grains allocated vide this sanction, by 31<sup>st</sup> July,2021 for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and 31<sup>st</sup> October,2021 for 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
- The cost of food grains shall be payable by the State Governments/UT Administrations to the Food Corporation of India (FCI). **As per this Ministry's letter No. CD-II-22/4/21-CD-II dated 15/04/2021 the additional incremental cost for Fortification of Rice has been worked out to be 0.73 per kg. Therefore, State/UTs are informed that the additional incremental cost arising on account of fortification of rice shall be absorbed by them from within their existing allocation under SNP.**

5. The State Govts/UT Administrations may indent the allocated quantity of food grains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of food grains to the State Govts/UT Administrations. Meanwhile, District-wise and Block-wise allocation of requirement of food grains may also be worked out and copies of the same may be sent to the Regional/District Officers of FCI and to this Ministry.
6. The stocks once issued to the State Govts/UT Administrations will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the respective State Govts/UT Administrations to ensure that the quantity of foodgrains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment at the prescribed rates in respect of foodgrains released by this Ministry under the Scheme.
7. The State Governments of Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and UT of A&N Islands may be allowed to draw their allocations from the DCP stocks under Decentralised Procurement System (DCP) vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.13-1/2012-BP.II, dated 14<sup>th</sup> February 2012.
8. The State Govts/UT Administrations are requested to ensure that at-least 70% of the foodgrains allocated for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter (including revalidated quantities) are lifted to enable them to lift foodgrains allocated for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and similarly, at-least 70% of the foodgrains allocated for the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters taken together are lifted to enable them to lift food grains allocated for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.
9. The allocated food grains should be lifted as per the revised guidelines laid down vide the Department of Food & Public Distribution's O.M. No.4-7/2018- BP.II, dated 25th April, 2019 and will be used for the beneficiaries of the ICDS Scheme only. The State Govts/UT Administrations are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting & utilization of foodgrains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.
10. All States Govts/UT Administrations are requested to send the consolidated Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the foodgrains allocated to them during the years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21. In case, they have already sent the UCs for these years, they may send a copy thereof to this Ministry [Shri K. Srinivasan, Under Secretary (E-mail: ksrinivasan.89@nic.in)].
11. States/UTs may kindly note that the allocation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of FY 2021-22 is an allocation subject to suitable adjustment in the third & fourth quarter based on Poshan Tracker data. Accordingly, States/UTs may complete the exercise of uploading category wise beneficiary data in the Poshan Tracker.
