Subject: Allocation of foodgrains to States/UTs to meet the requirement of Supplementary Nutrition under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) [Umbrella ICDS Scheme] during the 2nd & 3rd quarters of the year 2021-20.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to convey the approval of the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India for total allocation of **2249.01 (Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty Nine Metric Tons and Ten Kilograms Only)** MTs of Wheat {1124.50 MTs for 2nd quarter plus 1124.51 MTs for 3rd quarter} and **1265.91 (One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Five Tons Nine Quintal and Ten Kilograms Only)** MTs of Rice {632.95 MTs for 2nd quarter plus 632.96 MTs for 3rd quarter} at Central Issue Price (CIP) applicable for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) to the State Governments as per the quantities mentioned against each, for 2nd and 3rd quarter of the year 2021-22:

2. The allocated food-grains should be lifted as per the guidelines laid down vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2007-BP III dated 27.06.2011 and as per modified guidelines from time to time and used for the beneficiaries of the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) only. The State Governments/UT Administrations are requested to properly monitor the lifting and utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

3. The State Governments/ UT Administrations are requested to furnish the utilization Certificate for the food grains allocated for all the four quarters of the year 2020-21 and consolidated Utilization Certificates (UCs) earliest by 30.09.2021 and ensure timely submission of the off take/UC for the food grains allocated vide this sanction order. In case the report has already been sent for 2020-21, a copy of the same may be sent to this Ministry [ashvani.kumar@nic.in] at the earliest and latest by 30.09.2021.

4. The State Government is also requested to intimate the end use of the food grains allocated under Scheme for Adolescent Girls along with the offtake figures and Utilization Certificates (UCs).

5. The cost of the foodgrains shall be payable by the State Governments/UT Administrations to the Food Corporation of India (FCI).
6. The State Governments/UT Administrations may indent the allocated quantity of foodgrains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India (FCI). Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of foodgrains to the State Governments/UT Administrations. In the meantime, district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of foodgrains may be worked out and copies of the same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.
7. The Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Governments/UT Administrations to ensure that the quantity of food grains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of food grains released by this Ministry under the Scheme.
8. State Government of Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and UT of A&N Islands may be allowed to draw their allocations from the DCP stocks under Decentralized Procurement System (DCP) vide letter No. 13-1/2012-BP-II dated 14.02.2012 received from Department of Food and Public distribution.
9. This issues with the approval of Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development vide Dy. No. SAG/5/2021-SAG [E-95005], dated 28.08.2021.
