Subject: Allocation of food grains to Government of Telangana under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) for the 2nd Quarter of 2019-20.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to Department of Food & Public Distribution OM No.4-3/2019-BP-II dated 19.03.2019 regarding allotment of **25000 tons of wheat and 20000 tons of rice** at Central Issue Price (CIP) applicable for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) for the year 2019-20 and to convey the approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Women & Child Development to the allocation of **14.16 MTs of wheat and 56.7 MTs of Rice** for the second quarter of 2019-20 under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) to the following State Government as per details given below:

2. The allocated foodgrains should be lifted as per the revised guidelines laid down vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2007-BP III dated 27.06.2011 and used for the beneficiaries of the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) only. The State Government is requested to properly monitor the lifting and utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

3. The State Government is requested to furnish the utilization Certificate for the food grains allocated for the year 2018-19 immediately and ensure timely submission of the offtake/UC for the food grains allocated vide this sanction order.

4. The State Government is also requested to intimate the end use of the food grains allocated under Scheme for Adolescent Girls along with the offtake figures and Utilization Certificates (UCs).

5. The CIP of wheat and rice for BPL is Rs. 415/- and Rs. 565/- per quintal respectively, which is payable by the State Government to the FCI.
6. The State Government may indent the allocated quantity of food grains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of food grains to the State Government. In the meantime district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of food grains may be worked out by the State Government and copies of the same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.
7. Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Government to ensure that the quantity of food grains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of food grains released by this Ministry under WBNP for the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG).
8. State Government of Chhattisgarh, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh and A&N Islands may be allowed to draw their allocations from the DCP stocks under Decentralized Procurement System (DCP) vide letter No. 13-1/2012-BP II dated 14.02.2012 received from Department of Food and Public Distribution.
9. This issues with the approval of Secretary, MWCD, vide Dy. No. 69708 dated 18.07.2019.
