Dear Chief Secretary,

This is in connection with implementation of Scheme for Adolescent Girls introduced by the Government on pilot basis in 2010-11 during the XI Plan Period. Presently, the scheme is operational in 508 selected districts across the country, aims at all-round development of out of school adolescent girls of 11-14 years. The scheme has two major components Nutrition and Non- Nutrition Component.

2. In the year 2017-18, a sum of Rs. 422.75 crore have been released for Nutrition component and Rs. 23.54 crore for Non-nutrition component under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls. State-wise funds released for the Nutrition and Non Nutrition component are at **Annexure-1**.

3. The Scheme for Adolescent Girls has been extended to all the districts of the country w.e.f. 01.04.2018 and the Kishori Shakti Yojana has been phased out. Hence, from 01.04.2018 Scheme for Adolescent Girls will be implemented universally for out of school adolescent girls of age 11-14 years and KSY will cease to operate.

4. I would, therefore, request you to kindly consider reviewing the implementation of the scheme in your State/ UT and also advise the Principal Secretary concerned to conduct baseline survey for identification of the beneficiaries and intimate the same to the Ministry. I would further request you to ensure that the Quarterly Progress Report of Quarter 4 of 2017-18 along with Annual Progress of 2017-18 indicating component wise expenditure in the prescribed format are sent to the Ministry positively by 30th April, 2018. Savings under Kishori Shakti Yojana may also be intimated. This would facilitate timely release of funds in the financial year 2018-19.
