Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the UCs/SOEs received from 06 districts of Himacha Pradesh under the One Stop Centre (OSC) Scheme being implementing by this Ministry. The UCs/ SOEs have been examined and it has been observed that over 25% of the funds to be released during a financial year; is available with these districts for expenditure. As per latest guidelines, subsequent grants can be released only upon expenditure of over 75% of the funds. The details of the unspent grant-in-aid at the end of the FY 2021-22 are attached at **Annexure**.

2. In this regard, it is requested to take necessary action for utilization of funds in compliance of **Rule 230(7) of GFR, 2017** which states 'Cash balance at a time should preferably not be more than 3 months of requirements'.

3. However, if any districts have incurred expenditure during current year out of the funds available as on 31.03.2022, they are requested to furnish statement of expenditure (SOE) up to 31.08.2022 signed by concerned DC/DM so that further recurring grant can be released.
