Monthly Summary Report for the month of June, 2019 in respect of Ministry of Women and Child Development

The significant events relating to the work of Ministry of Women and Child Development for the month ending June, 2019 are as follows:

1. Joint Implementation Support Mission

Joint Implementation Support Mission with World Bank was organised under POSHAN Abhiyaan during 27th May to 4th June, 2019. During the Mission, joint visit to the selected States/UTs was organised.

2. Executive Committee Meeting under POSHAN Abhiyaan

7th Meeting of Executive Committee under POSHAN Abhiyaan was held on 10th June, 2019 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MoWCD to review the progress of POSHAN Abhiyaan. Senior Officers of States of Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Assam, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan presented Supplementary Nutrition Programme models being followed in their respective states. DCs/ DMs of Mamit (Mizorma), West Singhbhum (Jharkhand), Vidisha (Madhya Pradesh) and Gonda (Uttar Pradesh) made presentations on Early Childhood Care and Education/ Pre School Education initiatives in their districts.

3. 5th International Day of Yoga, 2019

The Ministry celebrating 5th International Day of Yoga on 21st June, 2019 at National institute of Public Cooperation and Child Development (NIPCCD), Hauz Khas, New Delhi.

4. One Stop Centres and Women Helpline

At present, 506 One Stop Centers are functional in 33 States/ UTs. Women Helpline is functional in 32 States/UTs.

5. Food and Nutrition Board

The Food and Nutrition Board under the Ministry of Women and Child Development, through its Community Food and Nutrition Extension Units in 30 States/UTs, conducted Inspections of 465 Anganwadi Centers for monitoring the Supplementary Nutrition Programme of the ICDS; 605 Nutrition Education Programs in the urban slums, rural and tribal areas for creating awareness about the importance of nutrition, diet diversification, proper cooking methods, etc. Low cost nutritious recipes were also demonstrated using locally available foods during the nutrition education sessions: 60 training programs on Home Scale Preservation of Fruits and Vegetables out of which 19 programme was exclusively for SC/ST beneficiaries were also organized.

Additionally, Food and Nutrition Board also conducted 112 Orientation Training Courses in Nutrition for grassroots level functionaries from ICDS and Health, adolescent girls, pregnant, newly married, communities and PRIs, etc.

6. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance:

- Video Conferences are being held on regular basis for inter-action and dialogues with States/UTs for effective implementation of various schemes
- Full-fledged e-Office implementation by Ministry has resulted in savings to Government exchequer; Also, substantial number of Inter Ministerial communications are made through e-mail.
- All Policies/ Programmes/ Schemes/ Acts/ Sanction orders etc. are loaded on public domain for easy access by stakeholders.
