I am directed to convey the sanction of President to the payment of Rs.26.69 lakh (Rupees Twenty six lakh sixty nine thousand only) to the following State Governments to the extent of amount indicated against each as grants-in-aid during 2018-19 towards GoI's share (90%) for non-Nutrition Provision under Scheme for Adolescent Girls:

2. The State Governments will maintain separate records of expenditure incurred for implementation of Scheme for Adolescent Girls and furnish separate Statement of Expenditure and Utilization Certificate along with Physical Progress Report every quarter. The information on expenditure on Nutrition Provision from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June must be furnished by 15<sup>th</sup> July, for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September by 15<sup>th</sup> October, from the period 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December by 15<sup>th</sup> January and from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March by 15<sup>th</sup> April to enable the Ministry to work out the entitlement of Central Assistance of each State Government.

3. This grant-in-aid is towards the expenditure on nutrition component for the Scheme for Adolescent Girls. The payment is provisional and is subject to final adjustment in the light of the audited figures of actual expenditure for the year as a whole.

4. Scheme for Adolescent Girls is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme in which the Centre and States both have contributions. The above funds are being released to States on the basis of cost sharing ratio of 90:10 between the Centre and States (for North Eastern and three Himalayan States). The sanction of funds is subject to the following conditions :

- i. The amount of grant will have to be utilized for all the components under the Scheme as per the schematic norms;
- ii. The States shall also be required to contribute adequate amount for implementation of the Scheme.

The information on expenditure for Non Nutrition component from 1st April to 30th June must be furnished by 15th July, for the period from 1st July to 30th September by 15th October, from the period 1st October to 31st December by 15th January and from 1st January to 31st March by 15th April to enable the Ministry to work out the entitlement of each State Government


