Subject: Sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 1,79,57,512/- to National Building Construction Corporation Limited for carrying out of repair work from seepage, water softening plant of 72000 lph and restoration of solar water heater tank of Working Women Hostel at Jasola - Release of **first** instalment.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Government of India has sanctioned a non-recurring grant of Rs. 4,48,93,781/- (Rupees Four Crore Forty Eight Lacs Ninety Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty One) for payment to NBCC India Limited towards carrying out of repair work from seepage, water softening plant of 72000 lph and restoration of solar water heater tank of Working Women Hostel at Jasola.

2. I am accordingly, to convey the sanction of the President to the payment to the to NBCC India Limited of a sum of **Rs. 1,79,57,512/- (Rupees One Crore Seventy Nine Lacs Fifty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Twelve only)** being the 40% of the total amount as the **first instalment** of the grant for carrying out of repair work from seepage, water softening plant of 72000 lph and restoration of solar water heater tank of Working Women Hostel at Jasola.

3. The grant shall be subject to further terms and conditions as laid down in the MOU. The organization will apply for second instalment i.e.40% of sanctioned cost of the project after completion 40% of work.

4. The Institute/organisation shall submit a component-wise Statement of Expenditure and Utilization Certificate as per prescribed format (**GFR-19-A**), certifying the actual utilization of grants for the purpose for which it was sanctioned. The organisation should have the capacity to actually spend the balance from the previous years and the releases during the current year.

5. The accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of **CAG (DPC) Act, 1971** and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Ministry, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so, as laid down under **Rule 236 (1)** of General Financial Rules. The grant-in-aid extended hereby is subject to the terms and conditions laid down in the grant-in-aid rules.
