**Subject: Release of funds to the Shopian District of Jammu & Kashmir during 2017-18 under Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme – reg.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Rs. 32,50,500/- (Rupees Thirty Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Five Hundred only) to the Shopian District of Jammu & Kashmir as grants-in-aid as 1st instalment (of six months) during the financial year 2017-18 for implementation of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme.

2. An amount of Rs. 5.41750 lakh (Rupees Five Lakh Forty One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty only) was released to the District in the F.Y. 2015-16. The District has submitted the Utilisation Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SoE) of Rs. 5,41,750/- and no unspent amount is available with the District.

3. *Ex post facto* approval of the competent authority is also conveyed on one time basis for the revalidation of Rs. 5.41750 lakh (Rupees Five Lakh Forty One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty only) towards the expenditure incurred by the district in 2016-17 without seeking prior approval of the Ministry. The UC and SoE furnished by the District for year 2016-17 has been accepted. The total amount of Rs. 32.505 lakh is available with the Shopian District of Jammu & Kashmir for carrying out the planned activities under Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme during the financial year 2017-18. The component wise maximum ceiling of expenditure is as under:



The District Administration will maintain separate records of expenditure incurred for implementation of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme and they are required to furnish separate Statement of Expenditure along with Physical Progress Report every quarter and Utilization Certificate is to be submitted half yearly, directly to the Ministry of WCD, GoI with a copy marked to the Principal Secretary, Department of WCD, Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir.
7. The payment is provisional and is subject to final adjustment in the light of the audited figures of actual expenditure for the year as a whole.
8. The expenditure is debit to the 2235 – Social Security and Welfare (Major Head); 02 – Social Welfare (Sub Major Head); 02.103 – Women’s Welfare (Minor Head); 70 – Mission for Empowerment and Protection for women; 09 – Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Campaign; 70.09.31 – Grants-in-aid General in Demand No. 99 Ministry of Women and Child Development 2017-18.
9. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, D-Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The payment of the Shopian District of Jammu & Kashmir would be arranged through NEFT/ECS. The State Accountant General/Deputy Commissioner will send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to the Principal Pay & Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, D-Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.
10. The pattern of grants has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme approved by the Competent Authority.
