Subject: Direct Benefits Transfer (DBT) in Pilot Districts

Madam/ Sir

This is in continuation to this Ministry D.O. letter of even number dated 7th December, 2012 and 20th December 2012 in connection with the rollout of Aadhaar enabled cash transfer under Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY). UIDAI priority districts in six states(Amaravati,North Goa,Dharwad,Chandigarh,North-West Delhi and Diu) have been identified for Direct Benefit Transfer under IGMSY on 1st January, 2013.


2. It has been decided that Direct Cash Transfer under IGMSY from 1st January 2013 in these districts will be made through the respective bank accounts of the beneficiaries in spite of the fact that whether all the bank accounts have been linked to the Aadhar base or not. This decision has been taken in the light of the fact that more than 90% Aadhar Cards are not available with the beneficiaries even if they have been enrolled for Aadhar. It has also been decided that for these districts the campaign of getting the Aadhar numbers for all the beneficiaries should continue unabated so that from 1st of February, 2013 all the transfers take place only through Aadhar linked transfer mechanism.

3. It is also clarified that if there are any Post Office Accounts of the beneficiaries, the money will be transferred to these accounts in the normal course of transfer as was being done earlier.

4. In the light of the above, it is requested to ensure the transfer of money that is due to the beneficiaries under IGMSY should reach to their bank accounts on 1st January, 2013 and for which the list along with the Aadhar numbers (for whom it is available) and the bank accounts should immediately be sent to your bank from where the money is to be transferred.

It is also requested that the progress may be sent by 5 p.m. of 1st January, 2013 with respect to number of beneficiaries and the amount transferred. The information may be sent directly to Dr. Vivek Joshi, Joint Secretary in his email address vivek.joshi@nic.in
